

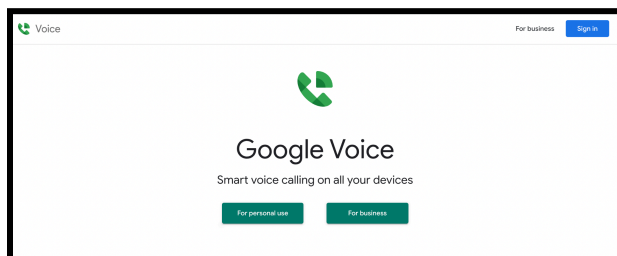
Google Voice

Note: Google updates the interface (look and feel) from time to time, so know that these screenshots are examples.

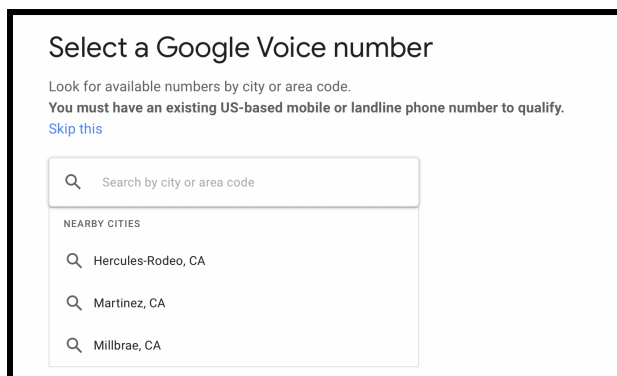
If you'd rather not use your personal phone for phone banking, setting up a Google Voice number might be a solution for you. It can be used on your phone with the Google Voice app or on a web browser on your computer.

To get started, you'll need to have a google account and be able to sign into it. Also, please note that the Google Voice account that you are about to set-up will be connected to your personal phone number though that number will be not be displayed in outgoing calls.

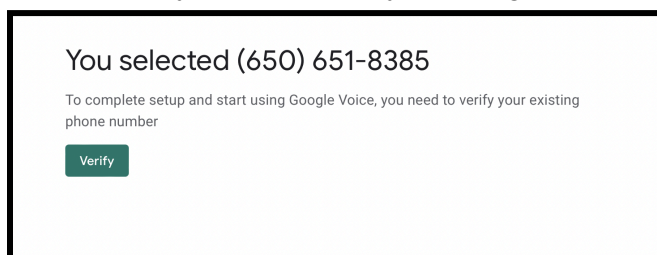
1. Go to voice.google.com on your computer and click on "for personal use".



2. Select the closest geographical location to you (the following screenshots show what was presented to me).



3. Once you've selected your Google Voice phone number, click "verify".



4. To verify, follow the instructions to do that with your personal phone.

Enter a number to link

Inbound calls to your Google Voice number will be forwarded to this number

Google Voice will send you a text message containing a 6-digit code. You can also [verify by phone](#).

5. Enter to code that you receive on your personal phone.

6. Once you are in Google Voice you can use the keypad in the lower right corner to make phone calls right from your computer. If you don't want your Google Voice to take incoming calls, it's recommended to confirm the settings (red arrow) to assure that.
